



IMOKILLY MOTOR CLUB Club Championship 2011 Regulations

1. Participants must register with the Membership Officer at least 24 hours before their first event.
2. Participants must be fully paid up members of IMC before the date of the event for which points are being claimed.
3. The 2011 championship will be based on a selected number of events.
4. To be eligible for the championship, participants must start at least two of these events.
5. The championship co-ordinator or his delegates shall be responsible for calculating points.
6. In all cases points awarded are at the discretion of the championship co-ordinator.
7. A championship table will be published on the club website periodically throughout the year.
8. Protests and queries about the awarding of points must be made to the championship coordinator.
9. The championship committee will decide protests and queries. If a participant is not satisfied with the decision made, then he/she may appeal through the championship co-ordinator to the club committee, whose decision is final.
10. In the event of a tie, the winner will be the one with the greater number of class wins or higher scores over any five events.
11. The championship co-ordinator reserves the right to amalgamate classes if there are insufficient numbers in any one class. In all cases the class being amalgamated would move up one class.
12. Trophies will be awarded annually at our awards night (usually held in January), based on the previous calendar year's performances. All perpetual trophies remain the property of the club and must be returned eleven months after receipt, or sooner if requested by the committee.
13. Other trophies such as "Best Newcomer" and the "Fender-Bender" etc, may be awarded at the discretion of the committee.
14. **The overall driver and navigator will each receive free entry to all Imokilly Motor Club events in 2012.**
15. Any competitor or competitor's crew bringing IMC into disrepute of any kind will be immediately excluded from the championship.

The Points System.

1. One point will be awarded if you start but fail to finish an event.
 2. Overall points will be scored as follows.

Any Club Member finishing lower than 16th Club Member home or 8th Club Member in class will be awarded 2 Points.

3. Three additional bonus points will be awarded to any participant finishing 1st in class in an event.
Two additional bonus points will be awarded to any participant finishing 2nd in class in an event.
One additional bonus point will be awarded to any participant finishing 3rd in class in an event.
10 points will be awarded to any participant who C.O.C's or assistant C.O.Cs on any Imokilly Motor Club event.
5 points will be awarded to any participant who marshals on any Imokilly Motor Club event.
4. Participants may select any one of the Imokilly Motor Club events for double points. This selection must be made at the time of registering for the championship.

Classes.

- Class 1.** Modified cars up to 1450cc – 2 wheel drive, normally aspirated with not more than 2 valves per cylinder.
- Class 2.** Modified cars up to 1450cc 2 wheel drive, normally aspirated with more than 2 valves per cylinder, and Modified cars 1451cc to 1651cc – 2 wheel drive, normally aspirated with not more than 2 valves per cylinder.
- Class 3.** Modified cars up to 1651cc 2 wheel drive, normally aspirated with more than 2 valves per cylinder, and Modified cars 1651cc to 2051cc – 2 wheel drive, normally aspirated with not more than 2 valves per cylinder.
- Class 4.** Modified cars over 1651cc to – 2 wheel drive, normally aspirated with more than 2 valves per cylinder.
- Class 5.** All 4 Wheel drive cars and Autocross Specials.
- Class 6. Novice Class:** For first time National B Licence holders in 2011.
- Class 7. Karting.**
- Class 8. Junior Class:** For 14-18 Year olds, participants must be under 18 on 01/01/2011.
